



# TIPID-TUBIG BARANGAY PATROL CONTEST



## CONTEST MECHANICS:

1. All 59 barangays are enjoined to participate in the TIPID-TUBIG BARANGAY PATROL contest for most number of points incurred for reporting leakages and illegal connections from their barangay.
2. All confirmed reported leaks/illegal connections from concerned citizens/concessionnaires will be credited to the concerned barangay. However, leak informants are still entitled to individual rewards being given by the San Jose Water under the Tipid-Tubig Patrol program. The report will be properly recorded in the Work Order database covering the location of leak.
3. Reported leaks on ball valve will not be considered because of the existing program wherein it is properly evaluated by San Jose Water personnel prior to its replacement.
4. Nature of leaks reported will be scored as follow:

*NOTE: leakages as a result of direct damage caused by concessionnaires and/or barangay personnel/contractors, whether intentional or unintentional, will not be accounted*

5. Nature of illegal connections reported will be scored as follow:

| • Unregistered connections/By-pass connections/<br>Double or More than one tapping    | = 10 points |
| • Illegal reopening of a disconnected connection<br>except reopening thur bolt & nut) | = 7 points  |
| • Tampered Water Meter/<br>Unauthorized use of booster pump                           | = 3 points  |

In order to get the final point score, number of service connections within the barangay will be considered using this formula:

$$\frac{\text{Total Accumulated Points/Quarter}}{\text{No. of Service Connections}} \times 100 \% = \text{Total Point Score}$$

6. Accrued points will be totaled and validated on the 1st week of succeeding month after each quarter to determine the barangay with the most number of points from reported leakages and illegal connections.

◆2nd Quarter – 1st week of July 2017

◆3rd Quarter – 1st week of October 2017

◆4th Quarter – 1st week of January 2018

7. The quarterly contest winners will be selected within the two political districts. The top three (3) winning barangays will be chosen from each district. Each quarter, six (6) barangays will be declared winners.

8. The following prizes await the barangays with most number of points from reported leakages and illegal connections

### Quarterly winners: (each district)

**1st Prize – P 100,000.00**

**2nd Prize – P 60,000.00**

**3rd Prize – P 40,000.00**

9. All quarterly winners and non-winning barangays are still qualified to be the Grand Winners. First three (3) barangays with the highest points earned for the year will be declared grand winners by January 2018 and will be awarded during the agency's anniversary celebration in July 2018.

### Grand winners: ( 1 set of winners only)

**1st Prize – P 150,000.00**

**2nd Prize – P 100,000.00**

**3rd Prize - P 50,000.00**

**Mode of Release:** Cash prizes shall be released thru Checks payable to the Winning Barangays.
